Application	Make Collect Calculate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Make a model of some Anglo-Saxon artefacts.</li> <li>Design an Anglo-Saxon costume Calculate the length of the Anglo-Saxon Age to modern times. Research a timeline of events.</li> <li>Make your own Anglo-Saxon weapons. Think about how weapons changed and developed throughout this period and why.</li> </ul>	4

Design or model your own home.</li> <li>Investigate how primary sources have helped us understand this period of history and can you show examples?</li> <li>Contrast the effects of the Anglo-Saxon invasion with the Roman invasion</li> <li>Compare Anglo-Saxon weaponry and armour with those of the Romans</li> </ul>	5
Evaluation	Judge Discuss Debate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Discuss your learning about Anglo-Saxon Britain with a family member– can you teach them any new facts? Write a report on what you have taught them.</li> <li>Were Anglo-Saxon laws fair and did punishments fit the crime?</li> <li>Debate whether you would prefer to live in an Anglo-Saxon village or a Roman town and give reasons for your answers</li> </ul>	8
