Comprehension	Explain Re-tell Compare	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Compare life in Liverpool to life in another UK city such as London or Edinburgh • Retell a story by a Liverpool author • Explain the best way to travel around Liverpool. Make sure that you visit all of the famous attractions that the city has to offer 	3
Application	Make Collect Calculate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make Scouse. Take photos and write a review of how it tasted • Write a report about the lives of some famous people from Liverpool • Make a scrap book collection of pictures of Liverpool over the years 	4
Analysis	Design Investigate Contrast	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Design and make a model of a famous building from Liverpool • Design a new front page for the Liverpool Echo. You can write about a real or an imaginary event 	5
Evaluation	Judge Discuss Debate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Would it be better to live in the city centre of Liverpool or Southport? Write a report giving reasons for your decision • Write a report explaining why Liverpool is a great city • Discuss Liverpool with an older family member and write a report about how different Liverpool was then 	8
Synthesis	Create Invent Imagine	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Create an advertising leaflet persuading people to visit Liverpool • Visit the Museum of Liverpool and write a report about a collection that interests you. Remember to take photos! 	8
